

2-years postdoc position at TU Munich

One postdoctoral position is available at the Center for Mathematics, Technical University of Munich, Chair for Analysis, with a flexible starting date no later than October 2021, in association with Professor M. Cicalese. The position is funded within the SFB Transregio 109 "Discretization in Geometry and Dynamics". The appointment is offered for two years in the first instance. At the end of the second year the possibility of an extension for an additional year will be considered. The successful candidate will join the research activities of the group and contribute to the development of the project "Geometric rigidity in spin systems".

Requirements

The successful candidate should have a solid education in mathematics.

- Qualifications: hold or be about to complete a PhD in mathematics or physics
- Expertise in at least one of the following areas: Calculus of Variations, Analysis of PDEs, Geometric Analysis.

Your duties

This is a research-oriented position without teaching duties. However, the successful candidate can choose to teach advanced topics classes at the Technical University of Munich.

What we offer

- A salary according to the TV-L 13 class (expected net salary around 2500 Euro per month).
